II- Background

Burkina Faso is in West Africa. Thousands of primary schools, especially in rural areas, lack basic educational materials such as proper buildings, desk chairs, and school supplies. Besides, schooling stays low in rural areas with high gender disparities.



III- Geographical location/ context

The primary school of Tanlalle is in one of the Northern villages of Burkina Faso named Tanlalle. The village is approximately 94 km far from the capital city and is very inaccessible during the rainy season (May-September). Burkina Faso has been threatened by terrorism attacks since 2015 and most of the rural areas are very inaccessible. On May 25th, 2023, a nearby village

named Mane was attacked by a group of terrorism. Because of the insecurity, we were not able to bring the different school supplies in person to Tanllale. We invited the leaders of the school to KAYA, a nearby city where we gave them all the supplies purchased.

IV- Budget and Achievement

We received a thousand (\$1000) dollars from River West Church).

Achievements

Below is a list of all the supplies purchased. In our proposal we wanted to buy 2 metallic cabinets, but we could not because the price was very high than expected. One cabinet is about 135000 XOF which is around \$223. The kids will be sitting their finals soon and we thought it was more beneficial for them to have more copy books and pens. We also increased the number of plants from 20 to 30. We took charge of the transportation of the leaders of the school as we could no longer go in the village.

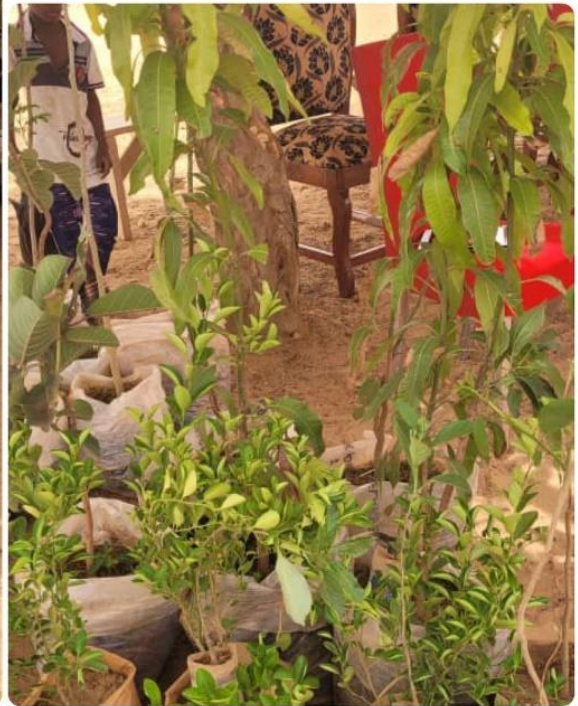
